Call For Papers

The 23rd CVWW 2018 is the annual meeting formed around four groups: the Pattern Recognition and Image Processing Group, TU Wien, the Visual cognitive systems laboratory and Laboratory for machine intelligence, Ljubljana, the Institute for Computer Graphics and Vision, TU Graz, and the Center for Machine Perception of the Czech Technical University in Prague.

The basic goal of the workshop is to communicate fresh scientific ideas within the four groups and to provide conference experience to PhD students. However, the workshop is open to everyone.

The CVWW 2018 is organised by the Czech Society for Cybernetics and Informatics. CVWW 2018 chairs and the organizational teams come from the Center of Machine Perception, spanning relevant groups of the Department of Cybernetics, Faculty of Electrical Engineering and the Czech Institute of Informatics, Robotics and Cybernetics (CIIRC), both part of the Czech Technical University in Prague.

Perspective authors are invited to submit a full paper in pdf of up to eight A4 pages of novel research material. Papers are to be peer reviewed by 2 or 3 reviewers.

The submitted papers are expected to present novel work. Accepted papers will be published in the workshop proceedings. A special category is the out-of-proceedings (out-of-the-review process) papers. Such papers will receive a feedback from experts (reviewers) and based on the feedback they can be accepted as student-invited talks. Out-of-proceedings papers will not appear on the internet or in the proceedings. Consequently, there will be no restrictions on submitting of the work elsewhere.
